

**Stacy Peardot-Goudy Agility Seminar**  
**November 19-22, 2010**  
**For Pet's Sake at The TajMahdog Arena**  
**Oakland, TN**

**About Stacy:**

Stacy Peardot-Goudy is a nationally and internationally recognized agility competitor & trainer. She is a popular seminar presenter who encourages every participant to give as much to the game as their dogs do in a positive and upbeat style. Stacy is an agility veteran whose dogs have earned the entire alphabet soup of agility titles (MACH2, O-NATCH x 2, ADCH x 7, MX, MXJ, etc.). She has qualified for the USDAA Grand Prix of Dog Agility the last 13 years in a row. Stacy and Secret represented the US at the IFCS World Championships in 2002 and 2004. In 2006 Stacy and Able represented the US at the IFCS World Championships. In 2002 she won the individual gold and led the team to 1st place. **Seminar Details**

Stacy will be at For Pet's Sake, Inc (MemphisAgility) for a 4 day seminar in a covered arena with dirt floor. There will be two sessions: masters/excellent and novice/starters. The masters/excellent session will be 8:30 am - 4:30 pm on Friday, November 19 and Saturday, Nov. 20, 2010. The novice/starters session will be 8:30 am- 4:30 pm on Sunday, November 21 and Monday November 22, 2010. There will be an approximately one hour lunch break all days. Each session is limited to 10 working slots. We will take applications and deposits from For Pet's Sake students and 4 PAWS club members first. Checks will be cashed upon receipt, unless applicant is put on a waiting list in which case the check will be held. Any checks that do not clear are subject to a \$30 additional fee, and payment in cash or money order is required to be received within three days of notification of returned check to prevent forfeiture of slot. The seminar will be held regardless of weather.

The cost of the seminar is \$190 per dog per session. (Each day is considered a separate session). This fee includes one working day plus one auditing day free. Any two working days: \$370 (\$185/day). Any 3 working days: \$540 (\$180/day). All 4 days: \$700 (\$175/day). Pay in full by July 1, 2010 for any working slots and pay \$175/day.

There will be a limited number (approx. 10) of auditing slots available each day at \$50 for one day, \$75 for two days, \$100 for 3 days or \$125 for all 4 days. Auditors may bring their dogs and will be permitted to work their dogs before or after the seminar, or during the lunch break. Auditors may not work their dogs during seminar hours.

Lodging information will be provided to participants with their confirmation of acceptance to the seminar.

**Requirements for Participation:**

**Masters/Excellent Level**

Dogs must be at least one year old and must be currently competing at the masters/excellent B level. Dogs must be able to work off leash with other dogs in close proximity and have no aggression issues.

**Novice/Starters Level**

Dogs must be at least one year old and must be competing in agility. Dogs must be able to work off leash with other dogs in close proximity and have no aggression issues.

**What to Bring to the Seminar**

- Yourself with an open mind
- Your dog on leash
- Crate for your dog
- Crate cover if your dog barks or whines in crate
- Chair for yourself
- Water for you and your dog
- Variety of treats
- Toy (if dog is toy-motivated)

## **Registration**

Registration forms must be signed and accompanied by a deposit of \$125 for one working day or \$200 for more than one working day. Registration is limited to For Pet's Sake (MemphisAgility) students and 4 PAWS members until February 1, 2010. Registration will be limited to those in the greater Mid-South area (Arkansas, Mississippi and Tennessee) until March 1, 2010. At that time if all slots are not filled registration will be open to the agility public. Once all slots are filled, additional applications will be placed on a waiting list. All fees are due by September 1, 2010 for all working spots.

If your payment is not received in full by that time your spot will be forfeited and your money will not be refunded. Checks are payable to Elaine Coupé and should be mailed to the address on the registration form. Refunds for cancellations will be made only if your slot can be filled and after deducting a \$10 handling fee.

## **Private Lessons**

If you are interested in private lessons, contact Elaine Coupé at the email or phone below BEFORE September 1, 2010. If enough people are interested in private lessons, Stacy will come a day earlier to accommodate that. Her fee for private lessons is \$125/hour. She is happy to split that among 2 or more people if you so desire.
